



## **Announcement: Photovoltaic System Donation to a Non-Profit in Taos County**

PPC Solar will be donating a 2kW photovoltaic (solar electric) grid-tie system to a **non-profit** organization in Taos County.

System specifications:

- Market value: \$8,000+
- Will produce approximately 2100 kWhs per year of electricity
- Increase your property's value (\$5,000 for every \$250 of annual electricity savings) without adding property taxes
- Eliminate 2,000+ lbs of CO2 emissions annually
- Comparable to planting 438 trees

Donation will be based on the following factors:

- Verification of 501(c)(3) status
- Desire from applicant
- Site/building criteria (applicant must own their building)
- Building electrical consumption
- Feasibility determination

- Environment
- Youth Services
- Health & Fitness
